- (b) The administration budget proposed to rescind \$11 million from the FY17 appropriations.
- (c) The administration proposed to create a rural infrastructure program and to fund continuation of the Section 504 Home Repair Grant program from that funding.
- (d) The amount that the House Appropriations committee allocated for the Section 504 home repair program is not clear from the committee report accompanying the proposed FY18 appropriations recommendations.

\*The House and Senate Appropriations shown in the table are only recommendations. The House and Senate must adopt these recommendations and they must then be reconciled between the two chambers. Moreover, even if there is a reconciliation of the appropriation, it is possible that the final numbers will be reduced by some percentage to accommodate a final budget resolution which has yet to be passed by either the House or the Senate.
