

REQUEST TO DISMISS MOTION FOR LEAVE TO  
PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Comes now John T. Manning, one of the attorneys of  
record for the plaintiff herein, and having previously filed  
on behalf of the plaintiff a "Motion for Leave to Proceed in  
Forma Pauperis," and comes now Donald R. Anderson, one of the  
attorneys for The Housing Authority of the City of Indianapolis,  
Indiana, and its Board of Commissioners, defendants herein,  
and show the Court as follows:

1. The Board of Commissioners of The Housing Authority  
of the City of Indianapolis on July 22, 1971, adopted a policy,  
as follows:

(a) Applicants for public housing will be given written notice if they are found to be ineligible for such housing, which notice shall include the applicant's right to obtain a review of such determination, said policy to go into effect by August 2, 1971.

(b) The LHA will continue to make every reasonable effort to inform applicants who are found to be eligible for public housing of that determination.

(c) The LHA, in verifying statements made by applicants as to their income, shall continue its current policies of (a) using public records, employer verifications, verifications from any agency, public or private, which provides the applicant with financial assistance, and similar sources, and the certification by the applicant on the affidavit forms attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked for identification as Exhibits "1," "2" and "3;" and (b) not requiring any applicant to obtain a divorce or legal separation as a condition precedent to placement in public housing.


2. The named plaintiff agrees to promptly furnish to LHA all information necessary to determine her current eligibility for public housing, and the LHA agrees to promptly

inform the named plaintiff upon receipt of said information of her eligibility status to obtain public housing.

WHEREFORE, the named plaintiff through her attorney, hereby requests that the Motion for Leave to Proceed in Forma Pauperis filed herein on the 21st day of July, 1971, be dismissed as moot on the basis of this Petition.
