bill of \$114.21, which was repair was made by the main-

tenance man at the apartment building. The District Court

further held as a matter of law that the plaintiff was

estopped in coming to Court claiming non payment of rent,

when in fact all rent had been paid in full through

December, 1985 and had been accepted and that non payment

of the repair bill was not in the District Court's judgment, a material noncompliance of the lease, when it is known fact that she was a poor person drawing AFDC. The Judge added "When your income is little, it is hard to get \$114.00 in 15 days and that must be taken into consideration."

This Court has gone through the entire file and finds that the District Judge made proper Findings of Fact and applied the applicable law. This Court HEREBY SUSTAINS THE FINDINGS OF BOTH FACT AND LAW AS MADE BY THE DISTRICT COURT.

The Judgment of the District Court IS HEREBY AFFIRMED.
