**ORDER OF COURT**

AND NOW, this 12 day of October, 2010, after a conference with counsel for the parties, and after consideration of the Reproduced Record and the parties' Briefs, the undersigned finds that the decision of the Housing Authority of the City of Pittsburgh to terminate Keisha Saunders' participation in the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program is not in accordance with the law (see 2 Pa. C.S. §754) as the participants engaging "in drug-related criminal activity or violent criminal activity..." were not "members of the household..." 24 CFR §982.551. Therefore, it is ORDERED that Keisha Saunders' appeal is sustained and the Housing Authority of the City of Pittsburgh is ORDERED to reinstate her in the Section 8 Housing Voucher Program.
